**This is Cornelius Vanderbilt he was a captain of Industry.**



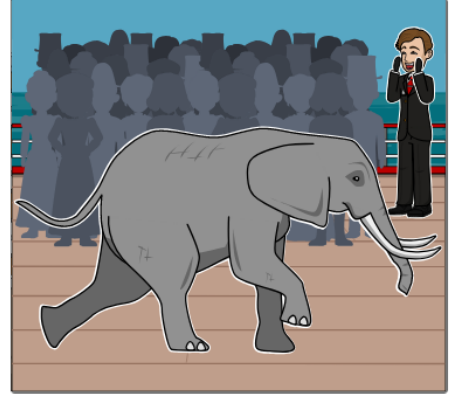
